Club Grants is one of Australia's Largest grant programs providing more than a 100 million in cash each year to a variety of worthy causes across NSW.



CATEGORY 1 CLUB GRANTS

For funding for projects and or services that contribute to the welfare and broader social fabric of the local community

CATEGORY 2 CLUB GRANTS

Allocation expenditure is that expenditure allocated to the community development and support activities and projects not listed under category 1 as well as expenditure allocated to a club's core activities. For example, Sport, Return servicemen's, League or veteran welfare, golf courses and bowling greens etc.

COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP OBJECTIVE:

Our objective is to build strong community partnerships by engaging with families, youth and local businesses. Entertainment, functions, dining sports and social clubs provide a pathway for our Club to become central hub for our community through social networking and in turn enhances growth for our Club to continue to develop.

HOW DOES A COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP WITH CULBURRA BEACH BOWLO WORK?

If you are eligible under Category 1 & Category 2 Club Grants you can apply via our website under Club Grants to be one of our twelve community Partners who will equally share a minimum of \$36,000.00 annually from Cat 1 & Cat 2 grants. So \$3000.00 each annually for all accepted partners plus access to additional grants and fundraising opportunities the our Community Partner month obligations and fund raising

COMMUNITY PARTNER MONTH OPPORTUNITIES:

The club will annual select 12 Cat 1 & Cat 2 community partners who is get a month to raise money and awareness for their club, sub club or charity organisation.

Each community Partner will need to hold at least one event in their community month and provide members to organise and run the events on each occasion.

Culburra Beach Bowling Club

will provide a month of Community Funding which will include:

- Free room hire for events
- Social media Exposure for the month
- Cover the cost of Meat, seafood and Club vouchers for there last Sunday of the month raffle fundraiser

In addition, we will offer to:

- Promote and sell Merchandise on behalf of our Community Partner
- Provide Donation tins for cash donations
- Access for further Cat 1 & Cat 2 additional grants if available

END OF MONTH COMMUNITY RAFFLE

We will conclude the month of exposure with our end of Month Raffle; with all proceeds being donated to our Community Partner. A Cheque presentation with all funds raised will be presented to a representative on the last Sunday month.

Examples of monthly financial community partnership agreement:

Minimum \$3000.00 per partner per month

- Raffle cost \$1000.00 "Covered by Club"
- Club donation Community Partnership \$3000.00
- Predicted Raffle Sales \$1530
- Predicted Bottle shop merch \$250.00
- Predicted Donations Tins Trivia \$220.00
- Predicted final Check donation \$5000.00

\$5000.00 to your Club and a month of exposure.

This doesn't include any money raised from club events such as partner fundraisers and trivia nights



COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP COMMITTEE

This committee could be filled with management, board members & community leaders.

This Committee will select all twelve community partners each year and have a set criteria and obligations to work of to make sure all partners are fulfilling there obligations.

Applying for Community Partnership Agreements

Our Intake opens 1st of April 2023 and closes 18th of August 2023. Go to our website after the 1st of April and download community Partnership Cat 1 or Cat 2 form and fill out the selection criteria and questions. Community Partnership committee will review applications after the 18th of August 2023 and notify grant recipients in September 2023.
